Wait for your name to be announced
Cross the stage to receive your diploma cover
Shake hands with Dr. Turner and turn toward photographer and pose for picture
Shake hands with Don Pate, Chairman of the Board of Regents
Descend steps and return to your seat from the front of the stage

- Recessional**
Dr. Turner will lead recessional followed by guests, faculty and graduates
