If you do not have high-speed internet, please make arrangements to order this service from your local provider. The minimum rates required are a1.0 Mbps upload speed and a 600kbps download. How to check Internet speed: Go to http://www.performance.toast.net to test "Upload Speed" and "Download Speed". The internet service provider's SLA (Service Level Agreement) is usually 70% of what you buy. At 256 Kbit you are promised 179 kbps. At 384 Kbit you are promised 268 kbps, etc.
